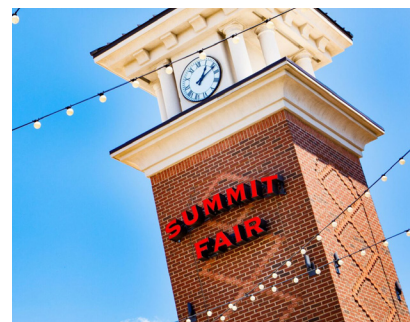
DOWNTOWN LEE'S SUMMIT
